AY Jackson Certificates and Awards



OCDSB Core French Certificate: Awarded to students who successfully accumulate 4 credits in Core French Including Grade 12

OCDSB French Immersion Certificate: Awarded to students who successfully complete the sequence of 4 courses in French as a Second Language and 6 additional courses in which the language of instruction is French.

OCDSB Extended French Certificate: Awarded to students who successfully complete the sequence of 4 courses in French as a Second Language and 3 additional courses in which the language of instruction is French.

OCDSB Business Certificate

To achieve a Business Certificate, (Non-Workplace) students must complete a minimum of <u>6</u> <u>Business credits</u> within 4 years of starting grade 9.

Basic Requirements:

- Minimum 50% in all Business courses
- Honours awarded for an 80% average for all 6 accepted courses
- Maximum 2 credits from Co-op that must be directly related to a business field
- Minimum 1 business credit from grades 9 or 10
- Minimum 3 business credits from grades 11 or 12
- No credits allowed from a workplace code

OCDSB Technological Studies Certificate: (8 credits) Awarded to students who successfully complete a sequence of 8 credits in Technology Studies and/or Computer Sciences

OCDSB International Certificate: Has 3 components.

- Component 1: an international language other than French.
- Component 2: international course work. Four grade 11 or 12 courses with an international focus and 2 major summative tasks with a specific international focus in courses between grades 9 and 12.
- Component 3: an international experience and engagement (hours accumulated travelling abroad or through internationally-focused organizations or school clubs).

Students may earn their Fine Arts Certificate with a *Visual* or *Performance Arts* concentration.

<u>AY Jackson Grade 12 Honour Society</u>: Overall average of 80% on 6 courses taken from September to June of <u>this year</u> at any grade level.

Ontario Scholar Award: Overall average of 80% on 6 grade 12 courses taken in <u>any year</u>.

OCDSB Silver Medal Selection Criteria: The following criteria established for the OCDSB Silver Medal, awarded to students achieving an <u>average of 90% or over</u> in each of their secondary years as follows:

In grades 9, 10 and 11, the courses (8 in grades 9 and 10; 7 in grade 11) used to calculate the Silver Medal awards could be at any grade level (e.g., a grade 10 student could be taking seven grade 10 courses and one grade 11 course). Courses may only be counted once towards a Silver Medal Award.

Grade 12 Silver Medal Award: the 6 courses must be taken at the Grade 12 level but need not be taken during the grade 12 year (Note: a grade 12 credit from the previous year could only be used if not previously counted for a Silver Medal award).

AY Jackson Subject Awards: Awarded to the student with the top marks in any course. In the case of a tie, it is awarded to both or multiple students.
